
1 放送を聞いて答える問題(28点)



When do you clean your whole house? Most of you will do it in December. But people in some countries do it in spring. Why do they do it then?

In the *past, many houses in some *northern countries had *fireplaces. Winter in these countries is very cold. So, people [wood / their houses / burned / make / to] warm. After the cold winter, there was a lot of *soot from the fireplace in their houses. So, they needed to clean their houses in spring. This is called "spring cleaning." Now, many people in those countries have other *heating systems in their houses, so they don't need to use fireplaces in winter. They don't need to clean their houses in spring, but they still have this *custom.

Different people have different ways of living. I think this is an important thing for you to remember to understand other cultures.


