Many things are left on trains or at train stations every day. For example, people often forget their phones, bags, or clothes. These things are usually brought to a train station. After a few days or weeks, the train station sends them to a police station. Then, after a few months, the police station has to *dispose of these things.

Among all of these things, umbrellas are forgotten the most. People often forget their umbrellas, but only about one in ten people returns to get them back. Umbrellas [not / small / are / as / as] most of the other forgotten things. So, both train stations and police stations need a lot of *space to () them. A ①

To *solve this problem, a *beverage company tried a new idea a few years ago. The company reuses umbrellas that people leave behind. B The company puts an umbrella box on the side of its *vending machines. If it starts to rain, and you have no umbrella, you can just take one from the box and use it. You don't need any money to borrow it. ② When it stops (rain), you should take it back to the box for the next person to use. C All of the umbrellas in these boxes are the ones that were left on trains or at train stations. This idea helps people walking outside on rainy days. It also helps train stations and police stations.

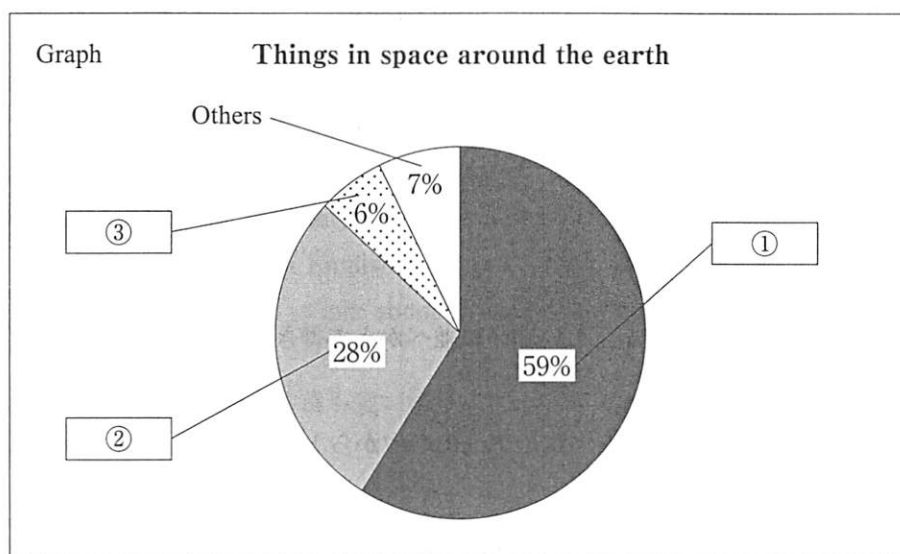

Today, I will talk about a problem in space: *space debris. There are a lot of things in space around the earth. Please look at this graph. It shows that about 6% of these things are *satellites made by humans and still *in use. Everything else is space debris. More than half of this space debris is broken pieces from rockets or satellites. This is followed by rockets and satellites that are not in use. All of the debris was sent into space by humans.

Why is space debris a problem? Here are two reasons. First, space debris is not safe. Space debris moves very fast, so it may hit satellites or *astronauts. Second, space debris makes more debris. If it breaks satellites, broken pieces from the satellites then become space debris, too. Most of the debris is so small that it can't be cleaned up. It will be more difficult to send rockets or satellites into space in the future because of space debris.
